In 2020, Fredericksburg removed its historic Auction Block, a symbol of the city's painful past, marking the beginning of a new chapter.

"Living Legacies" features compelling objects, images, and narratives, supported by a digital exhibition and catalogue, ensuring that the stories of Fredericksburg's African American community are preserved and shared for years to come. Visit this powerful exhibition, which opened in May of this year, and be part of a meaningful exploration of history and heritage.
